國際言語音聲學會(International Association of Logopedics and Phoniatrics, IALP)於1924年於奧地利維也納成立，是歷史最悠久的國際組織，致力於溝通與吞嚥障礙的認知與專業知識的提升，也是我國參與之重要聽力語言相關領域之官方組織；其中包含13個專業領域委員會：失語症(Aphasia)、音聲(Phoniatrics)、聽力(Audiology)、輔助溝通系統(Alternative/Augmentative Communication)、兒童語言(Child Language)、顱顏異常與相關症狀(Cranofacial Dysmorphias and Related Syndromes)、吞嚥障礙(Dysphagia)、音聲(Phoniatrics)、語言言語病理(Speech Language Pathology)、語暢(Fluency)、運動性言語障礙(Motor Speech Disorders)、多元文化事務(Multilingual Affairs)、與嗓音(Voice)。
